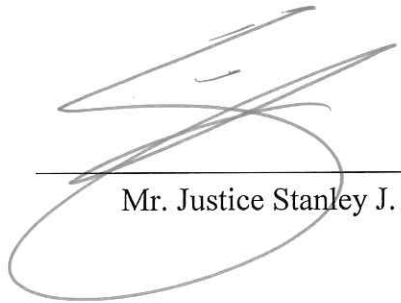
KERSHMAN J.

1. Kershman J. will be the case management judge of this matter until such time as the matter goes to trial.
2. No further expert reports will be filed by either party in relation to this matter.
3. The trial which was previously scheduled for April 2020 is adjourned to October 5, 2020 sittings. The matter is number two on the list which is a three-week sitting list.

4. Costs were previously ordered to be paid by Ms. Joubarne, of \$5,000 with \$2,500 being paid by March 18, 2020 and \$2,500 being paid by May 1, 2020. The Court confirms that these amounts are payable as aforesaid.
5. The Court notes that Mr. Lesage only has a limited retainer in this matter and may not be counsel at trial. The trial is peremptory to the Plaintiff in this matter.
6. Any further notices by the Defendants to the Plaintiff should be sent directly to Ms. Joubarne with a copy sent to Mr. Lesage.
